- 65,000 young people, families and individuals impacted annually



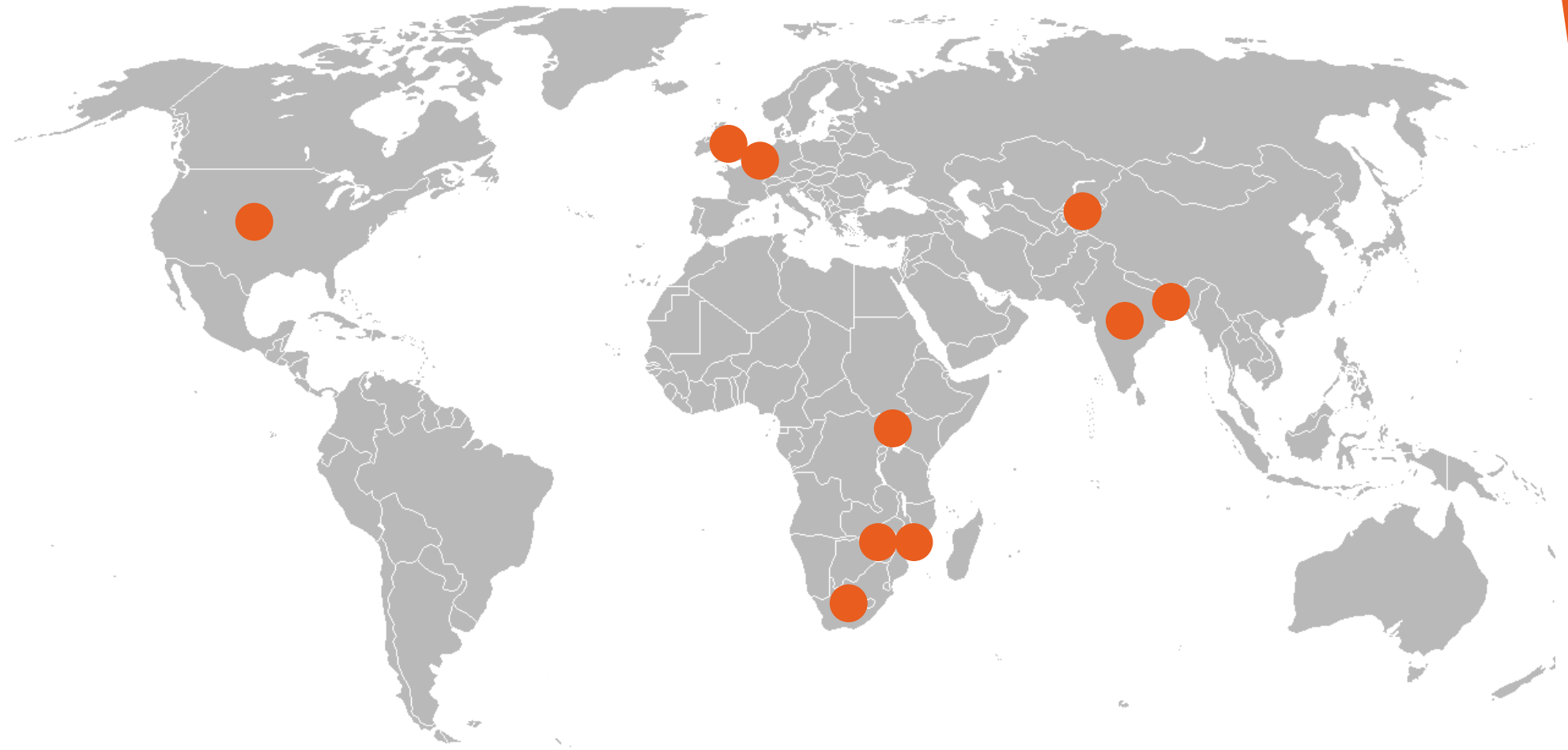

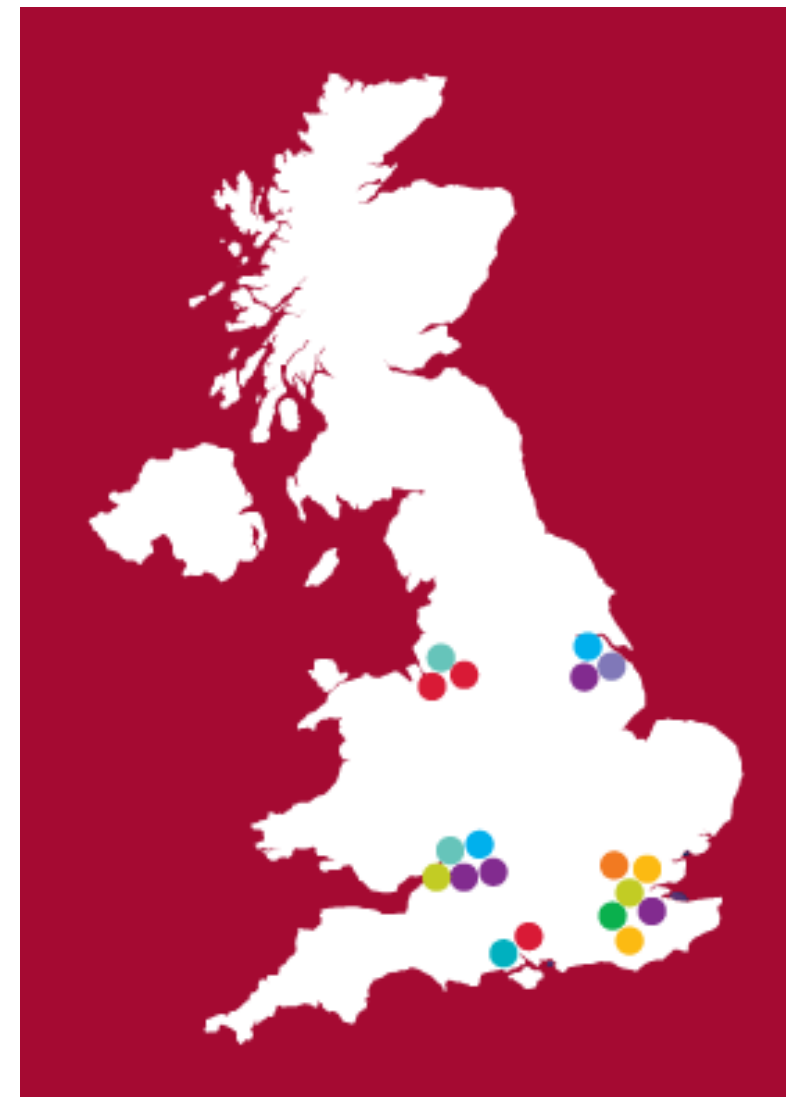
Where we work globally

Where we work nationally

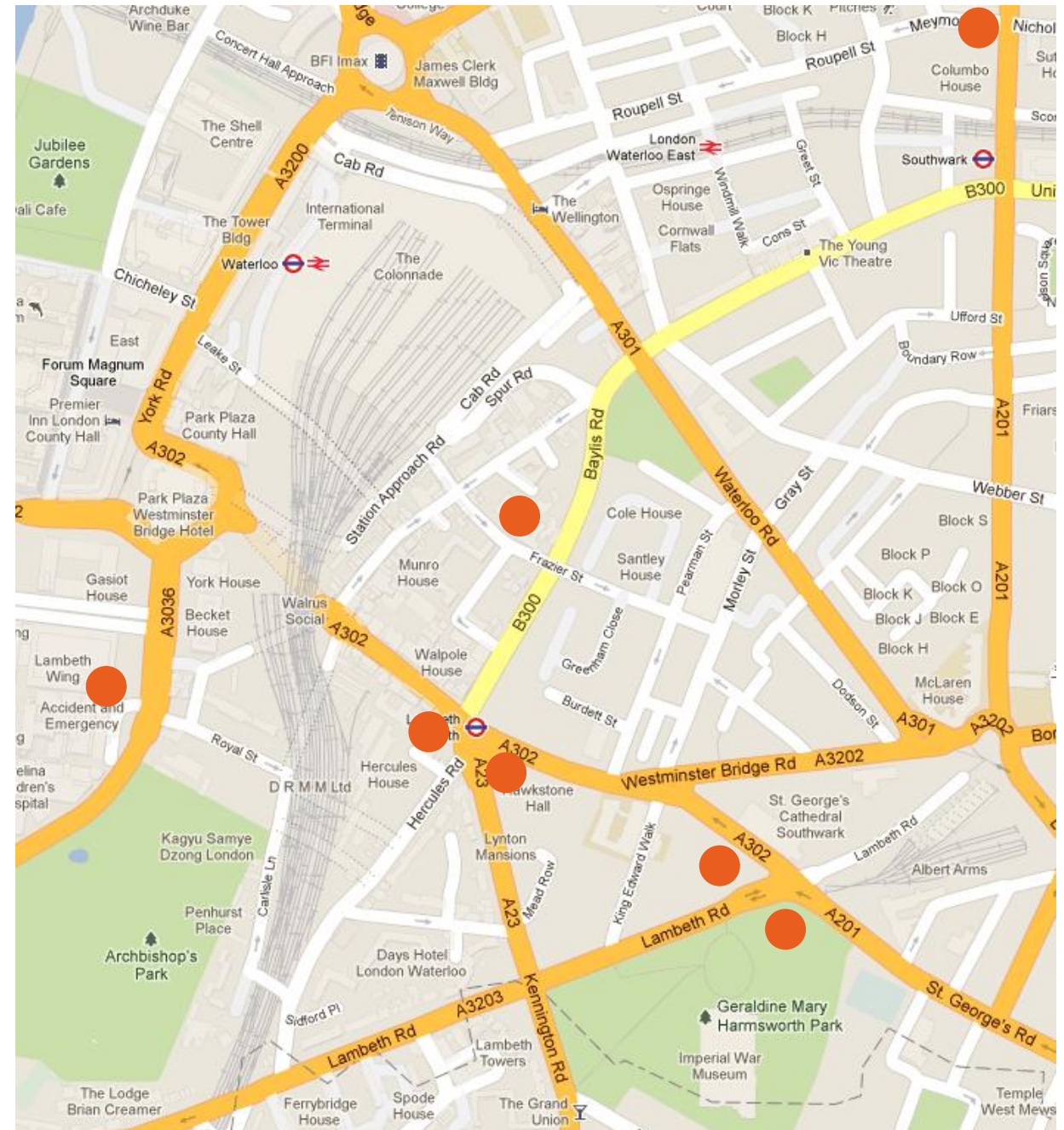
- Oasis now runs 19 Academies across the UK
- Each Academy is the launch pad for extended community support called a 'Hub'
- Oasis works with 15,000 young people every week and engages 1,500 volunteers
